Subject: **MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS AND CAREER ADVOCATES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GRADE 11 CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM**

1. Pursuant to the Regional Memorandum No. 17, s. 2017 which is entitled, MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS AND CAREER ADVOCATES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GRADE 11 CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM, a Regional Training will be conducted for the divisions of Nueva Vizcaya, Cauayan, Quirino, Ilagan and Santiago City on May 24-26, 2017 at Nick's Hotel, Alicia, Isabela.
2. The training aims to:
 - a) Capacitate the trainers in handling career advocacy and career path advising; and

4. Transportation expenses relative to the conduct of the training will be charged against local funds subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants are expected to be at the venue by 4:00 PM in Day 0 (May 23, 2017) with dinner as the first meal.

**MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS AND CAREER ADVOCATES FOR THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF GRADE 11 CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM**

To : Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. Consistent with the vision for the full and effective implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program geared towards producing graduates who are ready for the higher education, middle skills development, employment and entrepreneurship, the Department of Education through this Office will conduct the "Mass Training of Teachers and Career Advocates for the implementation of Grade 11 Career Guidance Program", as a follow through to DepED Order No. 41, s. 2015....
2. Due to the insufficiency of funds downloaded for the purpose, only *one participant* who is a Guidance Counselor, Career Advocate or Grade 11 Teacher from the schools offering Senior High School Program shall be accommodated. *A school may send more than one participant provided that it shall shoulder expenses for board and lodging of said other participant/s.*
3. The training aims to:
 - a. capacitate the participants in handling career advocacy and career path advising; and
 - b. prepare the participants' fortitude to guide, direct and help students determine their wants according to situations, conditions and marketability.
