**PROJECT NVIGORATE CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT THROUGH
 HEIGHTENED ACHIEVEMENT (NV CIA) APEX CUM CONTINUOUS
 IMPROVEMENT (CI) EXPO**

1. The Schools Division Office of Nueva Vizcaya through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct a Continuous Improvement (CI) Summit on December 22-23, 2020 at a venue to be announced soon.
2. The Summit aims to fully strengthen the Department's mandate of providing quality, accessible, relevant and liberating K to 12 basic education services to all its customers.
3. Its general objective is to present the district/school's best CI projects along curriculum, instruction and assessment.
4. It is organized in response to the Sulong Edukalidad (KITE) Program of the Department geared towards the following themes:
 - a. Continuous Improvement along Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment;
 - b. Interest Programs such as Special Program in the Arts and Special Program in Journalism;
 - c. Inclusive Education Program such as IPEd, ALS, Muslim Education and SPED;
 - d. Curricular and Special Curricular Programs like Reading Program, ELLN, STE, Multigrade, Kindergarten, Math Program, RIPPLES, SHS Joint Delivery Program and Child Protection Program among others.
5. All sessions shall be conducted in plenary sessions following the themes are enclosed in the Program Schedule.
6. The participants to this Summit are Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, CIC Chief, Education Program



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Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisor, District In-Charge, CI Team leader, selected elementary/secondary schools.


7. The districts' entry to the NV Project are requested to prepare a 3-fold (A4-size) NV CIA primer and a poster of their project (to be presented in a tarpaulin- 3ft-wide; 4ft-height). They are also advised to prepare 10-15 power point slide presentation. Likewise, they are requested to submit an abstract of their NV CIA project consisting of not more than 250 words to be submitted on or before December 15, 2020 thru this email **camodnumyar@gmail.com**

8. All other presenters (Inclusive Education program, curricular and special curricular programs) are requested to prepare a 5-minute power point presentation. Likewise, they are requested to prepare poster-abstract of their best practices in a tarpaulin (3ft-wide; 4ft-height).

9. Putting up of tarpaulin shall be done before the opening program on December 22, 2020. It is expected that the tarpaulin shall have been placed in a stand to avoid setting-up during the day of the Summit.

10. Expenses to be incurred in this Summit shall be charged against 2019 Basic Education Curriculum Continuing Fund except for the travelling expenses of the participants which shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

11. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

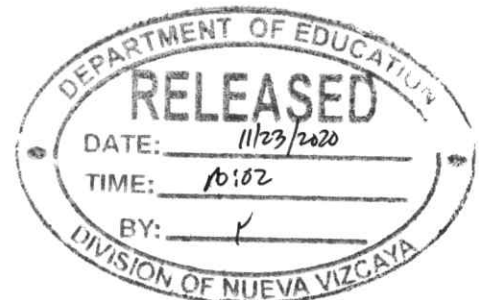
