BACK TO SCHOOL: LET A MILLION FLOWERS BLOOM PROJECT

1. The Office of the Undersecretary of Administration (OUA), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) will launch the “Let a Million Flowers Bloom” project for School Year (SY) 2021-2022 to uplift the spirit of learners, parents and teachers as well as to show gratitude and appreciation to teachers for all the hard work they have shown amidst the COVID-19 pandemic to continue the delivery of quality education.
2. The BLSS-YFD along with the Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya Youth Formation Unit encourages all schools located along highways to plant flowering plants and let them bloom in time for the opening of classes for SY 2021-2022. Each school through the leadership of the Youth for Environment in Schools-Organization (YES-O) teacher-advisers and/or the School Inside a Garden (SIGA) coordinators shall conduct the following activities:
 1. Designate a minimum of 10 square meters land area in front and/or by the side of the school and must be visible to the public. If the school has no available land area, the school can use alternative recycled materials like plastic bottles and sacks for planting the flowers.
 2. Plant sunflowers or any flowering plants available within the area of the school. Philippine native plants are recommended, such as kamuning, katmon, gumamela, etc.
 3. The school shall plant the saplings 1-2 months or earlier in time for the flowers to bloom and the opening of classes.



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

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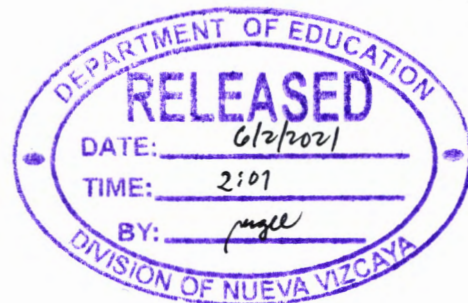


4. The school may seek partnership from their respective Local Government Units (LGUs), private sector, and even the parents/guardians of their learners for the said project.
5. The expenses to be incurred shall be charged against local funds/school MOOE in accordance with existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. The activity shall be performed in accordance with the local health protocols set in place in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic.
7. The YES-O Teacher-Adviser or SIGA Coordinator are requested to document the whole duration of the project and post these on their official School Youth Formation Facebook pages, tag the NuevaVizcaya YouthFormation Facebook Page and DepEd Tayo-Youth Formation-Division of Nueva Vizcaya facebook page accounts using the hashtags #DepEdProjectMillionFlowers and #depedkabataan2021. Photos should also be posted on the "BLSS-YFD-School in a Garden" Channel of the "OUA School Photos" Microsoft Team.
8. Each school shall submit a one (1) page narrative report with pictures of the said project at sdonvyfp@gmail.com. The Division YES-O and SIGA Coordinators from the Youth Formation Unit shall monitor the implementation of the said project.
