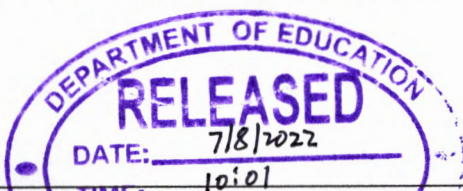

OBSERVANCE OF THE NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH 2022

1. By virtue of Executive Order No. 29, s. 2017, the month of July of every year is designated as the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) throughout the country. For this year, the theme is **“Sambayanang Pilipino, Nagkakaisa tungo sa Katatagan at Maunlad na Kinabukasan”**. The yearly observance emphasizes the importance of collaboration in addressing the challenges of Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management.
2. Anent this, our office will be conducting various activities that aims to increase disaster awareness and move towards disaster resilience supportive of the overall objective of this year’s observance of NDRM. One of the identified activities is an online information drive entitled **“Understanding Hydrometeorological Hazards, Its Impacts/Effects and Discussion on Prevention/Mitigating Measures to Lessen its Negative Effects”**. This will be conducted on July 20, 2022 and will be live via the *AHA Bestkaya* and the *DepEd Tayo - Youth Formation – Division of Nueva Vizcaya* pages. The participants to this are the teaching and non-teaching staff of SDO Nueva Vizcaya.
3. Further on July 22, 2022, there will be a tree planting/growing activity at the Small Water Impounding Project (SWIP), Darapidap, Aritao. This is in partnership with the Local Government Unit of Aritao and will be participated by the School DRRM Coordinators of Aritao and selected SDO personnel. Other details of this will be communicated thru the district DRRM Coordinators of Aritao. The other districts and schools are encouraged and/or coordinate with their respective LGUs on the conduct of similar activities.
