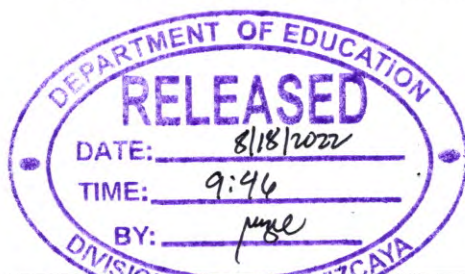

1. The Department of Education, Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya strongly supports the DOH program, Resbakuna: Sa Booster, PinasLakas! To achieve herd immunity in the entire country.
2. The School Health Section of this office intends to conduct vaccination activities in our division conference hall for our estimated 100 employees who still haven't received their booster doses yet.
3. In this regard, The DOH team will conduct vaccination activities on August 23, 2022 at the SDO Conference Hall from 9am to 4pm. All DepEd personnel are welcome to receive their 1st or 2nd booster dose following these guidelines:
 - a. (1st Booster)
Category A1 to A5 & B – 3 months from 2nd dose
ROPP 12-17 y/o – 5 months from 2nd dose
 - b. (2nd Booster)
Category A1 & A2 – 4 months interval from 1st booster
50 yrs old & above – 4 months from 1st booster
Immunocompromised – 3 months from 1st booster
