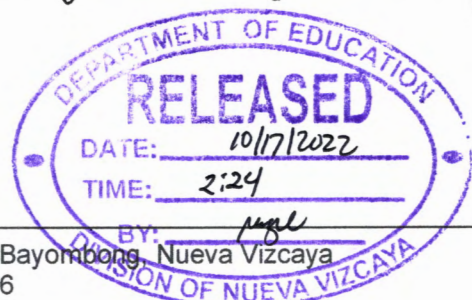

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NATIONAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLE'S MONTH 2022 CELEBRATION

Dayaw at Pagpupugay para sa mga Katutubo: Pag-ukit, Paghulma, Paglinang ng Kultura

Guidelines

1. This activity is open to all public and private secondary and elementary schools of Nueva Vizcaya. This activity is voluntary and not mandatory.
2. Only one (1) entry is allowed per school. Participants shall be composed of learners only. Teachers can give assistance in costumes, photography etc.
3. Registration of participants will start on Monday, October 17, 2022 at 12:00 AM and will close on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at 11:00 PM. Registration will be via google forms. Late registrants will not be accepted.

4. Participants will then be added to a Facebook group chat handled by the Division Federation Sixth Gen for further announcements and information dissemination.
5. Participants will then be required to submit the following via google drive on a google form link on Saturday, October 22, 2022 at 5:00 PM. Once the registration form has been closed, the submission form will automatically open.
 1. Photo of the indigenous people/tribe to be portrayed. Photo must be in portrait orientation, in a 3:4 ratio with the students as the main star of the photo.
 2. Captions must contain the name of the participant/s, school, short description about the tribe and costume (must contain a translation with the language used within that tribe). To be accomplished in a document form ro through Google docs.

6. Failure to submit within the given deadline will automatically mean that your school will not be included in the layout and posting.

Note:

1. The photo can only include 1-3 students with a background suitable for editing.
2. Submitted photos should be RAW with no edits. The layout for the photo will be done by the DivFed 6th Gen Officers.
3. This is not a contested activity. Certificates of Participation shall be given to the school and learner participants
