1. Every November, The National Library of the Philippines (NLP) and the National Committee on Libraries and Information Services (NCLIS) of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) commemorate Library and Information Services (LIS) month in accordance with Proclamation NO. 837 series of 1991 which declares the entire Month of November as LIS Month.
2. The theme for this year's commemoration is "**Mga Aklatan Bilang Kanlungan: Tagapangalaga ng Kultura at Pamanang Lokal**" which highlights the significant role of libraries in providing Services and Information in the promotion and preservation of Filipino Culture and Heritage.
3. In light of the celebration, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division - Learning Resource Management Section (CID-LRMS) will conduct the following competitions in the division level (*see Enclosure 1 for the mechanics and guidelines*):
 - a. Online Tandem: Book-Based Interactive Story Telling Contest (Boy-Girl Tandem for Grade 5-6)
 - b. Pinoy Book Character Online Contest (for Junior High School), and
 - c. My Day in the Library Contest (for Senior High School)
4. The submission of entries shall be per District with one representative only per category.

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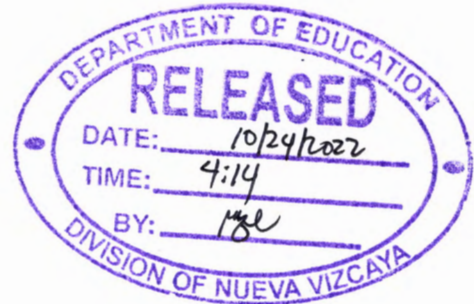
6. Certificates will be awarded to the top three winning entries/ coaches. The Champion in each category shall represent the SDO to the Regional level.

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
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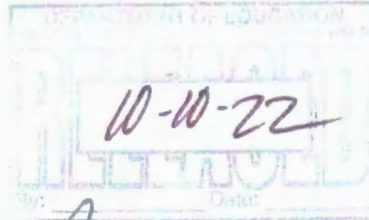

Theme : **“ Mga Aklatan Bilang Kanlungan: Tagapangalaga ng Kultura at Pamanang Lokal”**

Objectives:

- a) Promote reading and listening skills among Filipino Learners
- b) Develop the love for books and reading thereby enhancing their presentation and communication skills through story telling.
- c) Showcase their artistic prowess and enhance their writing skills.

A. Mechanics and Criteria for the Pinoy Book Character Online Contest

- 1) The contest is open to any Junior High School Student Grade (7-10) from private and public schools in the Region.
- 2) There shall be one contestant from each SDO.
- 3) Contestant will choose a book character that they are portraying and must prepare 2-3 famous lines from their chosen Pinoy book character.
- 4) Graphics and photo editing applications are allowed.
- 5) The video must not exceed 8 minutes and must be submitted in MP4 format with 480 resolution.
- 6) Sounds, instrumental or musical background are not allowed.
- 7) The criteria for judging will be as follows:

Criteria	Description	Percentage
Originality		10%
Creativity	(Costume appeal use of props to accentuate the outfit, Innovative use of recycled materials and resources).	40%
Characterization	(character portrayal, stage presence, delivery of lines, display and understanding of moods and emotions of the character)	40%
Audience Impact		10%

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- 8) The Regional Winners will receive the following Prizes:
- 1st Prize – P5,000 and a Certificate of Recognition to the contestant and coach.
 - 2nd Prize – P4,000 and a Certificate of Recognition to the contestant and coach
 - 3rd Prize – P3,00 and a Certificate of Recognition to the contestant and coach.

B. Mechanics and Criteria for the Tandem: Book-Based Interactive Storytelling Contest

1. The contest is open to Grade 5-6 pupils from private and public schools in the Region. The entry shall be a tandem storytelling performed by a Boy-Girl Tandem
2. Each SDOs must select a representative to join the said contest.
3. Contestant shall use the Filipino language in telling the story.
4. Only books published by Let's Read Asia (w.w.w. lets read asia.org) shall be used.
5. The book must be featured in the video. The storytellers shall mention the title, author, illustrator and publisher of the book.
6. The use of props, costumes, graphics and video editing applications are allowed.
7. Contestants are given 8 minutes for the presentation of story. Time shall officially start when the contestants utters the first word of the presentation. There will be point of deductions to the overall result for excess time. Deductions shall be follows 1-3 minutes – 5 points deduction. 4-6 minutes 1 point deduction, 7 or above minutes – 1.5 deductions.
8. SDOs shall submit/upload their entries in the google drive in MP4 format with 480p. resolution. Upload the entry in bit.ly/RO2 2021 Online Tandem Book Based Interactive Story Telling Contest.
9. Video must be clean and free from external noise.
10. The criteria for judging will be as follows:

Criteria	Description	Percentage
Story Telling Technique	The Story Telling should have voice projection, animated actions and interactions.	50%
Creativity and Visual Presentation	Adherence to the technical requirements and contain elements that are creatively and correctly used (i.e. text illustration, etc)	40%
Synchronization	Chorus lines are delivered if talking to the audience, same eagerness, same	10%

C. Mechanics of My Day in the Library Contest:

1. The contest is open to any Senior High School Student Grade 11-12 from private and public schools in the region.
2. Participants should visit any libraries in the region and create a mini vlog on how their day in the library went.
3. All entries must be an original work.
4. The Tiktok video should run in a minimum of 1 minute to a maximum of 3 minutes.
5. Schools Division Offices (SDOs) should submit one entry only.
6. Content must be appropriate for an audience of all ages. Video content must focus on any of the following:
 - a. Showcase local heritage collection of the library.
 - b. Promotion of library services
 - c. Importance/benefits of reading in today's world
 - d. Importance of libraries during this uncertain time.

7. The Regional Winners will receive the following:

- 1st Prize- P5,000 and a Certificate of Recognition to the Contestants and Coach
- 2nd Prize- P4,000 and a Certificate of Recognition to the Contestants and Coach.
- 3rd Prize-P3,000 and a Certificate of Recognition to the Contestants and Coach.

8. Participants shall submit the link of the tiktok to the management.
