1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2013-084: An Ordinance locally adopting Republic Act No. 9512 otherwise known as the Environmental Awareness and Education Act of 2008 Declaring the month of November of each year as Environmental Awareness Month, the Provincial Local Government Unit of Nueva Vizcaya through the Provincial Environmental Awareness and Education Team with its lead offices, the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office in cooperation with the Department of Education Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya - Youth Formation Unit will conduct contested activities involving the **public and private secondary schools in the province** with the theme **“Balon ng Buhay: Pahalagahan, Pagbabago ng Klima, ating tugunan.”**

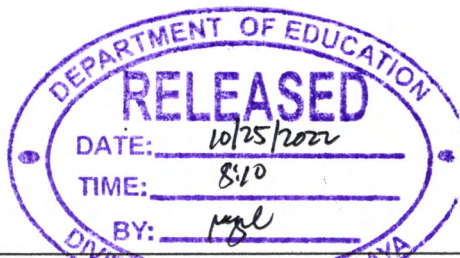
2. The following are contested activities for public and private secondary schools:

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**GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS OF THE CONTESTED ACTIVITIES ON  
ENVIROMENTAL AWARENESS MONTH FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE  
SECONDARY SCHOOLS**

**ACTIVITY 1. SAYAWIT PARA SA KALIKASAN**

**OBJECTIVES:**

- (1) To develop students' deeper awareness of the state of the environment focusing on significant issues and concerns;
- (2) To involve students in worthwhile programs, projects, and activities for the environment;
- (3) To create powerful, informative, and engaging songs and dances on environmental protection and conservation.

**GUIDELINES:**

1. All contestants are required to like the official facebook page account of DepED Nueva Vizcaya's Youth Formation Unit - **DepEd Tayo - Youth Formation - Division of Nueva Vizcaya**
2. A minimum of fifteen (15) and maximum of twenty (20) student participants shall perform the Sayawit para sa Kalikasan.
3. All student participants shall not be limited to the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O). Student Participants from any student who is a member of a recognized school club or organization or any student participant from any grade level without a certain club or organization are allowed to join.
4. Dancers and singers are considered as performers.
5. The performance must consist of a song and dance presentation on the environment particularly to this year's theme: **"Balon ng Buhay: Pahalagahan, Pagbabago ng Buhay ating tugunan."** Participants must actually sing and dance at the same time.
6. Any song in English, Filipino or any dialect may be used or a combination thereof may be utilized.
7. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes, in which period shall be included in the introduction and exit of the performers.
8. Live accompaniment shall be allowed.
9. The presentation must have environmental relevance and significance.
10. Props and costumes should be at the minimum, only. Use of recycled materials are encouraged.
11. Only one group shall represent a secondary school. (may it be public or private).
12. Avoid inappropriate words, choreography and costumes.
13. Participants can do or create their own videography (steady or free-shot angle) and shall be documented on a landscape orientation and in high definition.



14. Deadline of submission of entries will be on **November 18, 2022** at exactly 05:00PM. Send entries at <https://tinyurl.com/Sayawit>. Sender shall create a folder in the g-drive link renamed to the School Name (do not abbreviate). Within that folder, attached are the following:
- (1) Video Performance
  - (2) Word Document that shall include:
    - \*list of full names of the student participants,
    - \*full names of coach/es
    - \*lyrics of the song performance piece.

*Note: Non-submission of any of the required documents of the competition entry will automatically be disqualified.*
15. Each entry shall start accepting **only heart reacts** in Facebook on November 19, 2022, once the entries are uploaded by the DepEd Tayo - Youth Formation - Division of Nueva Vizcaya facebook page account for the **Sayawit para sa Kalikasan People's Choice Award**. Heart reactors must like and follow the DepEd Tayo - Youth Formation - Division of Nueva Vizcaya facebook page account. The heart reacts shall officially end and be counted on November 23, 2022 at 7:00PM
16. An online judging shall be implemented to determine the Top five (5) schools. The Top 5 shall be announced through the said facebook page on November 23, 2022 in no particular order.
17. All top (5) schools shall perform and be judged face-to-face at the Provincial Capitol during the Culminating Activity of the Environmental Awareness cum YES-O Month on **November 25, 2022**.
18. The top (5) group contestants shall only be accompanied by their respective coach/es.
19. Sayawit para sa Kalikasan shall receive:
- People's Choice Award – 3,000Php
  - 5<sup>th</sup> placer – 6,000Php
  - 4<sup>th</sup> placer – 10,000Php
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> placer – 15,000Php
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> placer – 20,000Php
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placer or Best Sayawit para sa Kalikasan– 30,000Php
20. Sayawit para sa Kalikasan shall be judged according to the criteria for judging:
- Relevance to the theme- 30%*
  - Voice Quality- 20%*
  - Precision of Dance Movements – 20%*
  - Originality/Costume 20%*
  - Projection and Over-all Impact 10%*
  - Total: 100%*



## ACTIVITY 2. TiktoKALIKASAN (Tiktok para sa Kalikasan)

### OBJECTIVES:

- (1) To develop students' deeper awareness of the state of the environment focusing on significant issues and concerns;
- (2) To involve students in worthwhile programs, projects, and activities for the environment;
- (3) To create a powerful, informative, and engaging tiktok video that showcases local environmental initiative or program

### GUIDELINES:

1. This competition is open to all Junior and Senior High School Students from both Public and Private Schools in the province.
2. There will be two categories (a) Junior High School (b) Senior High School. The tiktoKALIKASAN video entry should feature only one (1) Tiktok user.
3. The tiktok video shall only include one (1) student as main character. The tiktok video may include other individuals but are not permitted to narrate or host.
4. The participant must showcase an environmental initiative, environmental program or action in line with this year's theme: **"Balon ng Buhay: Pahalagahan, Pagbabago ng Buhay ating tugunan,"** in a cheerful, lively, and creative manner through a Tiktok video that is not **MORE THAN ONE (1) MINUTE**.
5. The participant can explain the piece in English or Filipino.
6. All contents in the tiktoKALIKASAN video must be original and owned by the participant. All creative visual tools such as animation, audio, simulations, physical demonstrations, or visual aids are allowed provided these are acknowledged in the credits of the video. The contestant will be held accountable to any issues that may arise regarding the originality and accuracy of the content.
7. The following tiktoKALIKASAN video format are highly recommended:
  - **File size:** the tiktoKALIKASAN video should be up to 287.6 MB in size for iOS, or 72 MB on Android.
  - **Orientation:** tiktoKALIKASAN is formatted to be viewed on a smartphone, so vertical video is best.
  - **Dimensions:** tiktoKALIKASAN dimensions should be 1080 x 1920.
  - **Aspect Ratio:** The aspect ratio should be that of a standard smartphone screen, 9:16. 1:1 is also possible, but it won't take up the whole screen.
  - **File Type:** tiktoALIKASAN supports .mp4 and .mov files.
8. Entries must be submitted on and not later than November 18, 2022 via g-drive to <https://tinyurl.com/TikToKalikasan> on or before 5:00PM.



9. School logo, uniform, name of school should not be highlighted in the presentation to avoid any form of bias.
10. The sender shall create a folder in the provided g-drive renamed to the school name and shall attach the tiktok entry along with a word document that will consist of the following:
- Complete name of the participant
  - Name of school (no abbreviation)
  - A pdf file of file of the video script.
- Note: Non-submission of any of the required documents for the competition will automatically be disqualify the entry.*
11. The Technical Working Committee reserves the right to remove, reject, or disqualify any entry if it:
- violates the terms of service and privacy policy of tiktok
  - infringes, misappropriates, or violates any rights of any third party including but without limitation to patent, copyright, trademark or right of privacy or publicity.
21. An online judging shall be implemented to determine the Top five (5) schools. The Top 5 shall be announced through the said facebook page on November 23, 2022 in no particular order.
22. All top (5) schools from the Junior and Senior High School categories shall be attending the Culminating Activity of the Environmental Awareness cum YES-O Month and their entries shall be judged on **November 25, 2022**.
23. The top five contestants shall only be accompanied by the Coach or Adviser.
12. The tiktoKALIKASAN will be judged according to the following criteria:

24. Winners shall receive:
- Junior High School Category:**
- 5<sup>th</sup> placer – 1,500Php
  - 4<sup>th</sup> placer – 2,000Php
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> placer – 2,500Php
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> placer – 3,000Php
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placer or Best TikToKalikasan– 3,500Php
- Senior High School Category:**
- 5<sup>th</sup> placer – 1,500Php
  - 4<sup>th</sup> placer – 2,000Php
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> placer – 2,500Php
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> placer – 3,000Php

### **ACTIVITY 3. PASIKLABAN NG PROYEKTONG MAKAKALIKASAN**

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

- (1) Recognize the programs of the SSG and YES-O that created an impact and addressed the issues and challenges on environment in their school and community
- (2) Instill the act of proposing unique innovations for the school, teacher and learners spearheaded by the Supreme Government and YES-O.
- (3) Empower the Department of Education's core value "Makakalikasan" and the PRAYERS N' FAITH's "Protection of the Environment" program.

#### **GUIDELINES:**

1. A project on the environment which shall be spearheaded and submitted by the SSG Organization and YES-O of each public and private school with one project entry per school.

2. Each group shall submit a project proposal may it be:

- (1) A new project/innovation,
- (2) The project shall instill Environmental Awareness, Environmental Protection and Preservation and anything in between.

3. The project proposal entry must revolve on the amount of one hundred forty thousand pesos (**P140,000.00**) to be funded by the Provincial Local Government Unit of Nueva Vizcaya through the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office

4. Search Process:

1. Accomplish the Official Application Form and Project Proposal Template to be downloaded at <https://tinyurl.com/PasiklabanMakakalikasan>
2. Use white, A4 size bond paper, Font size: 12, Font: Times New Roman, enclosed with green sliding folder.
3. Do not attach other documents that are not required for submission.
4. Lack or non-compliance to the requirements will result to automatic disqualification.
5. All decision of the Panel of Judges are final and irrevocable.

5. All entries shall be submitted to the Records Section of the Department of Education Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya on or before November 18, 2020 at strictly until 5:00PM. Failure to submit complete documents on the said date disqualifies a school to be included in the list of entries.

6. Entries shall be shortlisted through paper assessment and top five (5) proposals shall be announced at the Youth Formation Unit Facebook Page. Upon announcement, finalists shall be qualified to the provincial screening wherein both SSG President and YES-O Presidents shall defend their proposal and be judged on



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November 25, 2022 during the Culminating Activity of the Environmental Awareness Month at the Provincial Capitol, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.

7. The SSG President and YES-O President shall be accompanied, only by the SSG or YES-O Teacher-Adviser. Any officers of the SSG or YES-O may replace their presidents in case their President is not available for the defense.

8. The Best Project Proposal shall be implemented by the Winning school to be scheduled by the Department of Education Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya - Youth Formation Unit in partnership with the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office

9. Winning proposal of the winning school shall receive one hundred forty thousand pesos (**P140,000.00**) for project implementation.

10. During the Paper Assessment, proposals shall be judged on the following Criteria for Judging:

Impact of the Project	- 30%
Teamwork on Implementing Projects	- 25%
Creativity and Innovation	- 25%
Effective Use of Resources	- 20%
TOTAL	-100%

11. During the Defense Proper, proposals shall be judged on the following Criteria for Judging:

Impact of the Project	- 30%
Teamwork on Implementing Projects	- 25%
Creativity and Innovation	- 25%
Effective Use of Resources	- 10%
Communication Skills	- 10%
TOTAL	-100%
