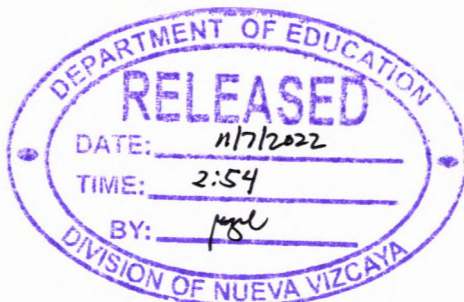

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MECHANICS FOR THE Search for Best GCED/SDG Jingle

1. COMPOSITION

- The jingle must be in Filipino/English language.
- It must be relevant to the theme and the objectives of the activity
Theme: GCED/SDGs in Naturally Vibrant Nueva Bestkaya
Objectives:
 - a. Provide an overview of Education for Sustainable Development and Global Citizenship Education,
 - b. Share stories and Best Practices on SDG innovation,
 - c. Motivate other SDOs and organization to promote ESD and GCED, and
 - d. Take inspiration and ideas from presenters to improve the implementation and promotion of the advocacy.
- The time duration for the jingle must not be more than (3) minutes.
- It must be an original composition made by the learners and may be through the guidance of a music teacher/coach.
- Any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment.

2. PARTICIPANTS

- The contest is open to all learners of public elementary and secondary schools
- Composer can be either an individual or a group of learners.
- Only 1 entry per school

3. ENTRY FORMAT AND REQUIREMENTS

- Jingle entries shall be submitted in an MP3 format with the title of the Jingle entry as the file name.
- Entries must be sent via sdonvqced2022@gmail.com with the following requirements:
 - Accomplished Entry Form
 - Narrative report on the concept of the jingle
 - Profile of composers and the music teacher/coach. (Note: this might be found in the Entry Form)

4. ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

- The decision of the judges will be final and irrevocable.
- Winners will be announced through a DepEd Memo
- The winning entry shall be notified via email through the School Head.
