**18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND  
CHILDREN'S RIGHTS**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/District In-Charge

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 1172, s. 2006 and Republic Act No. 10398, which states that from November 25 - December 12 of every year and National Consciousness Day for the elimination of violence against women and children, a Resolution No. 2022-4380 of the 11<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Nueva Vizcaya encourages all “Novo Vizcayanos” to stand up for women and children’s rights **every 25<sup>th</sup> of November** which marks the beginning of the 18-Day Campaign to end violence against women.

2. In this light, the Department of Education Schools Division of Nueva Vizcaya through the Youth Formation Unit encourages all public and private elementary and secondary schools to **wear orange every November 25** in solidarity with the campaign to end the widespread and persistent violence against women and children.

3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools are also encouraged to fully support and participate in the information dissemination of the resolution which is attached in this memorandum.

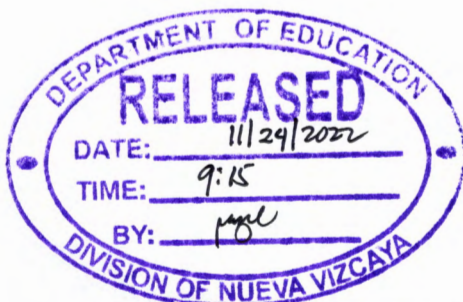
4. All public and private elementary and secondary schools may initiate programs, activities and projects in line with the said 18-Day Campaign.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-4380**

**A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING ALL NOVO VIZCAYANOS TO STAND UP FOR WOMEN AND CHILDREN'S RIGHTS THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE ORANGE DAY CAMPAIGN EVERY 25<sup>TH</sup> OF NOVEMBER WHICH MARKS THE BEGINNING OF THE "18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN", AND OTHER ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TO PROCLAMATION NO. 1172, SERIES OF 2006 FROM NOVEMBER 25 TO DECEMBER 12 OF EVERY YEAR, AND "NATIONAL CONSCIOUSNESS DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN" PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10398**

WHEREAS, the 18-Day Campaign to end Violence Against Women (VAW) is observed annually from November 25 to December 12 to raise awareness among our people that VAW is a public issue of national concern;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Proclamation No. 1172, series of 2006, all departments and agencies of the national government, including state colleges and universities, Local Government Units (LGUs) and all other sectors of society are enjoined to actively support and participate in the protection of human rights of women against violence and all other forms of discrimination;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of R. A. No. 10398 states that the following activities shall be undertaken in observance of this occasion:

- (a) Heads of government agencies and instrumentalities, government owned and controlled corporations, local government units and employers in the private sector shall, together with their employees, organize, engage or participate in activities designed to raise public awareness on the problem of violence, and the elimination of all forms of violence, against women and children;
- (b) The Philippine Information Agency shall be mandated to allocate a minimum of one (1) hour airtime for programs exclusively raising public awareness on the problem of violence against women and children and the elimination of all forms of violence against women and children. Relative thereto, all television and radio networks nationwide are encouraged to allocate airtime for the said programs;
- (c) Publishers of local newspapers and magazines are encouraged to highlight the problem of violence, and the elimination of all forms of violence, against women and children; and
- (d) The Department of Education, the Commission on Higher Education and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority, in coordination with the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) and the Department of Social Welfare and Development, women nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) and other NGOs and people's organizations advocating for women's and children's human rights, shall lead public and private school communities at all levels in organizing consciousness-raising activities on the problem of violence, and the elimination of all forms of violence, against women and children.

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government Unit of Nueva Vizcaya is one among other provinces across the country that observe, raise awareness and demonstrate commitment in upholding the basic rights of women and children now and onwards;

WHEREAS, in solidarity with the campaign to end the widespread and persistent violence against women and children, the wearing of orange every 25<sup>th</sup> day of November is encouraged;

WHEREAS, as a show of support to this endeavor, the lady legislators are encouraged to religiously practice the wearing of orange or with a touch thereof not only from November 25 to December 12 but during their sessions, meetings and other activities to raise awareness of Violence against Women and children's rights;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Eunice Galima Gambol, jointly seconded by Hon. Patricio F. Dumlaog, Jr., Hon. Elma Pinao-an Lejao, Hon. Primo Percival J. Marcos and Hon. Marizel A. Reyes, be it,-

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to pass a resolution encouraging all Novo Vizcayanos to stand up for women and children's rights through participation in the Orange Day Campaign every 25<sup>th</sup> of November which marks the beginning of the "18<sup>th</sup> Day Campaign to end Violence Against Women", and other activities, pursuant to Proclamation No. 1172 from November 25 to December 12 of every year, and "National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and Children" pursuant to Republic Act No. 10398;
