1. The Schools Division Office of Nueva Vizcaya through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the 3rd **NV**igorate **C**ontinuous **I**mprovement for Heightened **A**chievement dubbed as “PROJECT NV CIA 3.0” Summit on December 07, 2022 at DepEd Conference Hall, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.
2. The Summit aims to fully strengthen the Department’s mandate of providing quality, accessible, relevant and liberating K to 12 basic education services to all its customers in response to the Sulong Edukalidad (KITE) Program of the Department thru the presentation of the district’s/school’s best CI projects along curriculum, instruction and assessment.
3. The participants to this Summit are the Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, CID Chief, Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisor, District In-Charge, CI Team leader, selected elementary/secondary schools.
4. The districts’ entry to the NV Project are requested to prepare a 3-fold (A4-size) NV CIA primer and a poster of their project (to be presented in a tarpaulin- 3ft-wide; 4ft-height). They are also advised to prepare 10-15 power point slide presentation. The whole package of the project are expected to be submitted on or before December 2, 2022. Districts/schools who have submitted their entry prior to the release of this memorandum is acknowledged. Soft copies of their abstract consisting of not more than 250 words are requested to be submitted on or before December 5, 2022 thru this email camodnumyar@gmail.com
5. Putting up of tarpaulin shall be done before the opening program on December 6, 2022. It is expected that the tarpaulin shall have been placed in a stand to avoid setting-up during the day of the Summit.



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6. Expenses to be incurred in this Summit shall be charged against 2022 HRTD Fund except for the travelling expenses of the participants which shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

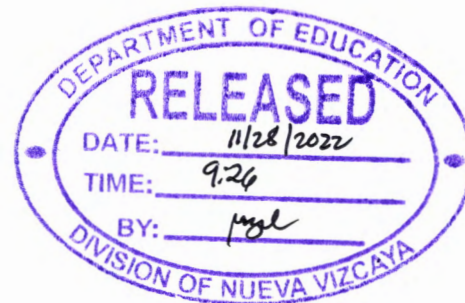
