

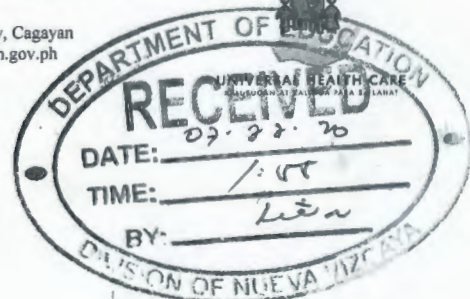

Dear Sir ;

The effectivity of the Universal Health Care (UHC) law on 22 November 2019 ensured the automatic inclusion of every Filipino citizen into the National Health Insurance Program. Its goal is to make possible for every Filipino to have immediate access to health services. In order to realize this, we have to enable Rule III, Section 8.3 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Universal Health Care law which states that, "Direct contributors shall register and/or update their records and premium contributions with PhilHealth upon the effectivity of these Rules" through the implementation of policies and adoption of systems and procedures to achieve an accurate database.

As members of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) under the Formal Sector, employees of your office are considered as **Direct Contributors**. The updating and registration is now being done through the procedure prescribed under PhilHealth Circular No. 2020-0001, which enjoins all new registrants and existing PhilHealth members to accomplish and submit to PhilHealth their revised PhilHealth Membership Registration Form (PMRF) for the issuance of a unique and permanent PIN and/or to update their membership profile or information.

At this juncture, we are giving you a master list of employees registered under your agency for reference in your updating and a copy of our revised PMRF for each of your employees to accomplish. The PMRF may be reproduced or downloaded from our website, www.philhealth.gov.ph. We also require a supporting document for each declared dependent. For the list of documentary requirements, you may again access our website and refer to PhilHealth Circular No. 2020-0001. Please submit to the nearest PhilHealth Office the following documents, or arrange with us the schedule of pick-up, until July 31, 2020;

1. Properly accomplished PMRF of ALL your employees;
2. Supporting document for each of their declared dependent;
3. Report of Employee-members (ER2), which should be signed by the head of agency or the authorized representative.

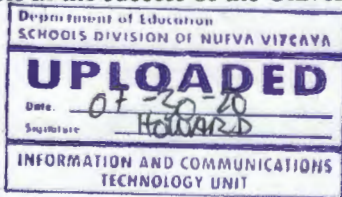
As a final note, we would also like to inform you about PhilHealth Circular No. 2020-0008 which discusses the payment of premium contribution through the online payment facility of the Electronic Premium Remittance System (EPRS). The online payment shall be mandatory effective the applicable month of June 2020. A copy of the circular and the list of accredited collecting agents with payment gateway/facility interlinked with the EPRS may be downloaded from our website.
