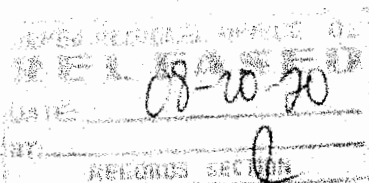
- a.) Directory of the Development Team for video/TV lessons scripts and
