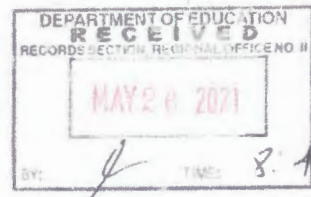

**Subject: DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION ON THE
CLIMATE CHANGE YOUTH SURVEY**

Anchored on a regional study on Enhancing Local Response to Child Protection in Climate Change Disasters in South East Asia, the United Nations Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF), together with the International Federation of Red Cross (IFRC) and the Global Partnership to End Violence against Children, designed the Climate Change Youth Survey.
